1. PURPOSE

- Eric Glosser formed united Paranormal Project on February 22, 2011. The purpose was to search for the existence of spirits, demons or any other paranormal entities. These members all were previously a part of the Central Ohio Ghost Squad (COGS), resigned there and started their own Paranormal Research Team to follow their own beliefs in the Paranormal World.**

- The UPP is staffed with some of the most reputable paranormal research investigators in the country. UPP TV and 4 Horsemen Paranormal Radio is two bureaus that have been implemented by UPP Management.**

2. MAIN OBJECTIVES

Requirements to be a UPP Member:

- **Total Honesty**
- **Objectivity**
- **Patience**
- **Courage**
- **Strength of Character**
- **Working well on a Team**
- **Attending investigations (Attendance is of the up-most importance)**
- **Professionalism**
- **Having fun and enjoying what you are doing**
- **Listening and Respecting Senior Investigators and Management**

3. CHAIN OF COMMAND

Founder >>> Directors >>> Members by seniority. These positions are the managing body of U.P.P. A member may hold more than one position if deemed necessary by the Founder.

a. The Founder – Has the final say of all aspects of the UPP. The Founder may delegate positions within the UPP to aid in the groups functions.

Founder will manage all personnel and functions of the UPP

b. Directors – Director of History and Research, Director of Case Management, Director of Tech & Analysis, Director of Case Management, Director of Media Relations, Director of Public Relations, Director of Intuition & Psychic Analysis. Each position will be equal in status. In the absence of the Founder at any UPP event the most Senior Member will be in charge. The order of seniority can be seen on the website in the members section.

4. MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- **Members shall purchase at least one official UPP Shirt and keep it well maintained and clean for investigations.**
- **Members are required to attend at least 60% of all UPP functions. This includes: All UPP Hunts, Public Hunts and other UPP Functions. Excluded from this requirement: Private Hosting's at the Bryn Du Mansion and Twin City Opera House, which are pay events from other Teams to investigate the two above mentioned locations.**
- **Members are required to have adequate transportation to and from all UPP functions.**
- **Members are not required to purchase any equipment, but may do so at their own expense. If a member has his/her own equipment, all footage and/or audio shall be copied and given to the tech manager. If you don't intend on doing this, then don't use your own equipment.**

5. ROLES

- **Director of History and Research – Shall conduct research and history about locations the UPP will be investigated.**
- **Director of Case Management – Shall manage all cases and investigations for the UPP.**
- **Director of Tech & Analysis - Shall be in charge of Tech, Equipment & Analysis.**
- **Director of Media Relations – Shall maintain the Media Operations for the UPP.**
- **Director of Public Relations – Shall serve as the Public Relations Person for the UPP.**
- **Director of Intuition & Psychic Analysis – Shall be in charge of all Psychic and Intuitive aspects for the UPP.**
