UNIT V: TYPES OF INVESTIGATIONS

1. Understand the different types of Investigations.
2. Understand how each type of Investigation is approached.

1. PURPOSE OF KNOWING THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF INVESTIGATIONS

- Each new UPP member shall learn the different types of investigations that the United Paranormal Project (UPP) has implemented.

2 THE TYPES OF INVESTIGATIONS

1. Private / Residential Investigations:

A civilian having a possible paranormal problems in their home usually initiates these types of investigations. These cases are sensitive and confidential. These cases shall NOT be discussed with anyone outside the UPP membership. UPP Management will determine what is to be said to the Client or anyone not a member of UPP. The cases must be researched as much as possible before investigating them. The Case Manager shall obtain as much information as possible in reference to the type of activities going on there. In some cases the Client may want the activity to stop and/or explained to relieve the stress and uncertainty that the unknown activity causes. These cases take priority to any other cases and are a priority in getting scheduled quickly.

2. Pay Site Investigations:

These investigations are generally of historic and known haunted locations. These places are more than often open to the public for a pre-determined fee. Many of these locations require liability and hold harmless indemnity forms to be signed by each member investigating there. These investigations are usually for our own interests, experiences, understanding and pleasure. UPP exclusively reserves and rents out the entire facility for a Private Investigation.

3. Hostings:

These are when UPP sets up an opportunity for other Paranormal Groups to conduct an investigation at one of 2 haunted locations that UPP manages. These are in sense Our Pay Site Investigations where other paranormal groups pay to investigate one of two locations we offer. Usually 2 UPP members are scheduled to be at the location rented out and they will act as a Host & Tour Guide. Each UPP member shall learn the history, hazards, and as many paranormal tales as possible about the location. They are also there to answer any questions our guests may have. They will also be responsible for the building, which includes turning off the lights; let the group in or out of the building. In some rare instances the group may ask the Hosts to participate in the Ghost Hunt with them. The two locations that UPP currently manages are:

There is a second type of Hosting that is provided by UPP called Public / Community Ghost Hunts. These Hunts are open to anyone for a fee. UPP Members will actively participate and supervise these Ghost Hunts. The guests will have the luxury of using UPP Equipment during the hunt.
